- A male was advised Angiography
 - Procedure was explained
 - Planned to do via Femoral Route
 - He wanted that his SATAR should not be exposed
 - And he did not want to stay on bed post procedure so that he can offer prayers
 - Radial route was adopted



Per Rectal Examination during Fasting

- Patient called a doctor post Fissure surgery that he has a follow up appointment
- Can he Fast, since Per Rectal examination breaks fasting
- He was reassured that PR will not be required

He Fasts



Colonoscopy advised

- It was important to have it done early
- Patient was fasting but was advised to take colonoscopy solution orally and start preparation immediately and he agreed

- Is this permissible?
- He was advised to take solution after aftaar




